- C) Straight line vs pooled reserves this item was tabled until January until more people will be around for discussion.
- D) Attic door repairs & ladder upgrades Stilling getting bids from vendors
- 8) New Business-
 - A) Insurance update- Was hoping to have a new proposal from insurance agent Jim Cirillo for the 2021-2022 term but have been told it will be out in a few weeks.
 - B) Looking at setting up a seminar with Jim Circillo so he can come in to speak with everyone regarding their individual policies.
- 9) Master Board update.
 - Gym will be reopened on May 2nd from 7 a.m 6 p.m., you will need to sign up and agree to enter at your own risk.
 - Security committee is working on installing lights
 - Master board has approved \$45,000 for additional landscaping
